In Judah [is] God known: his name [is] great in Israel. In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in Zion. There brake he the arrows of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah. (Psalms 76:1-3)

It is not all that hard to identify the true church of the living God. Of all the religions of the world which tout a god of some sort, and of Christendom that claims to be the church that our Lord built, the only ones that will meet the criteria are those where *God is known, where His name is great, which is manifestly His tabernacle, His dwelling place.* It is impossible, too, that His people should not know His greatness, for He it is Who has for them broken the arrow and the bow, the shield and sword of battle. For them He has plundered the stouthearted, made hands of mighty men useless, and cast both horse and rider into the deep.

This shallow, flimsy, frivolous counterfeit that passes for Zion today is a poor counterfeit. It bears no resemblance to the people of faith. Only a fool could imagine God to be in the midst of it. And none but those in the darkest of delusions could fail to recognize the Presence of God that marks out His peculiar people.

No, there will be no excuse at the Judgment for men who claim to have been duped by religious hucksters. His sheep know His voice and they follow Him.
